

Suggested Art Supplies to have at home:

General Supplies:

- Crayons (twist up crayons are my favorite)
- Colored pencils (I love prisma color)
- Package of Broad and fine point markers
- Permanent Colored Sharpies - both fine point and extra fine point
- Extra fine point black sharpie & fine point black sharpie
- Sketch book or loose-leaf paper. (I personally do not use a sketch book but instead, **NEENAH bright white paper**. This is a thicker paper that takes mixed media well. Can found at target, staples or amazon and comes in bulk)
- Clip board (I use a flat clip board to save on space - this hold my paper to use as a small workstation)
- Scissors
- White Glue, glue stick
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- X-acto Blade (for older learners)
- Cutting board /workstation

In the Kitchen:

- Bag of flour
- Salt
- Tinfoil
- Food coloring
- Recycled cereal and food boxes

Found object materials:

- Buttons
- Fabric scraps (from old clothing and t-shirts works)
- Yarn
- Cardboard (thick and thin - Cereal and food boxes are really easy to cut)
- Wood (driftwood, twigs, scraps)
- Beads
- Shells
- Plastic containers (water bottles, juice bottles, detergent, etc)
