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**Snowflakes:** A snowflake begins to form when an extremely cold water droplet freezes onto a pollen or dust particle in the sky. This creates an ice crystal. As the ice crystal falls to the ground, water vapor freezes onto the primary crystal, building new crystals - the six arms of the snowflake.


- **Select ONE out of the activities below / on the following pages to complete for this week.** The idea is to develop an appreciation for complex structures in nature and observe patterns in nature in relationship to the Real World.

### SNOW FLAKE THEMES! (Select One Activity)

- **Drawing Snowflakes:** Requirement: Draw 3 unique and original snowflakes.
- **Coffee Filter or Copy Paper Snowflakes:** Requirement: Create 3 snowflakes - either out of coffee filters, copy paper, recycled paper, etc.
- **3-D Paper Snowflake:** Requirement: Create 1 three-dimensional snowflake
- **Pasta Snowflake:** Requirement: Create 2 detailed snowflakes using pasta or other items from your household. Does not need to be glued down or painted. Simply take a picture and dismantle afterwards.



Create at least 3 paper snowflakes using the guidelines and link on the following pages. Paper ideas: Newspaper, magazines, circular coffee filters, paper bags.


## How to Cut Snowflakes and Printable Patterns

### SNOWFLAKE INSTRUCTIONS (REFER TO PICTURE BELOW & NEXT PAGE)


1. Cut 4" squares out of your book pages
2. Fold the square into a 90° triangle
3. Fold the triangle in half to form another 90° triangle
4. With the point of the triangle down, fold one side of the triangle up, going a little past midway.
5. Fold the other side of the triangle onto the side you just folded. It should meet up with the previously folded side.
6. You will now have 2 points sticking up off the top. Turn the triangle over and cut those points off using the edge of one of the previous folds as your guide. You will be left with a triangle that you can draw a design on and cut out.

# SNOWFLAKE PATTERNS/DESIGN IDEAS... ONCE YOU GET YOUR "FOLD" PREPARED AND READY



**COFFEE FILTER SNOWFLAKES:** Create at least 3 coffee filter snowflakes using the guidelines and link on the following page.

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[Coffee Filter Snowflake Instructions](#)

1. Fold in half to make a semi-circle and then in half again to make a triangle.
  2. Fold the triangle in thirds by turning the two straight sides in towards the center so you end up with a skinnier triangle. Adjust these as needed so that all the edges line up before creasing.
  3. Snip along the folded edges. Open carefully and enjoy!
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


## 3D SNOWFLAKES:

### 3-d Snowflake Step by Step Visual Instructions



**PASTA SNOWFLAKES:** Create at least 2 pasta snowflakes using the guidelines and link below. Get as creative as you want!

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**Supplies:**

- Parchment paper
- white craft glue

[Pasta Snowflake Instructions](#)

1. Dried pasta (mixture of large and small)
2. Working on parchment paper, glue pasta edges together into a snowflake shape; let dry. **OPTIONAL** Paint white or other colors, add glitter, let dry.
3. Mix glue and water at a one to one ratio, paint on pasta snowflakes, let dry
4. **If you can not glue together, simply make different snowflake designs on a flat surface and take photographs. Discard pasta afterwards.**
