CREATE A POP ART MEMORIAL DAY SOLDIER:

Instructions are below however you are welcome to recreate and draw your own soldier or come up with your own patterns and color schemes. Coloring worksheet can also be found on next page.

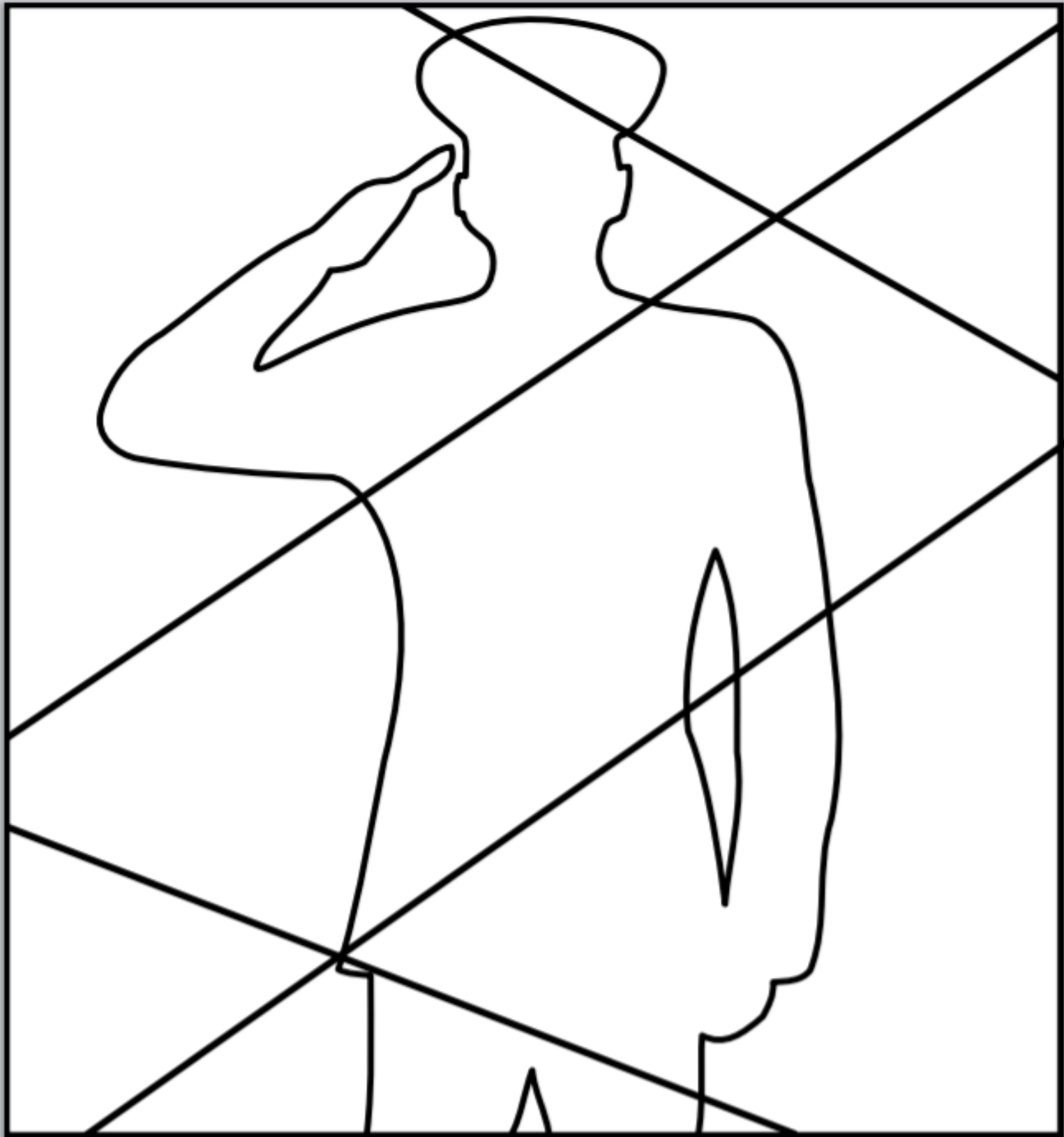
1. Using the patterns in the five small boxes at the bottom of each page, fill in the different parts of the pictures (by drawing the pattern in). Every time you run into a black line you need to change the pattern. You don't have to put patterns in all the areas, you can leave some blank. It's okay to repeat the patterns in different sizes in different areas.



2. Color all the shapes and patterns. Use crayons, colored pencils or markers.

3. Cut out the large rectangle at the top with the finished work. Display for all to see!
